

Craftsman's Guide

1. Definition:

Algerian law defines craftsmanship and craftsmanship as: "any activity of production, creation, transformation, artistic restoration, maintenance, repair or service provision dominated by manual labor and practiced predominantly and permanent".

As for the craftsman, it means: "The craftsman is any natural person registered in the register of craftsmen with the Chamber of Crafts and who carries out a traditional, productive activity which concerns, creation, transformation, artistic restoration, repair or the performance of a service dominated by manual labor."

For anyone meeting the following conditions to practice the activity:

- be at least 18 years old;
- demonstrate their professional qualification;
- enjoying civic rights;
- Proof of ownership or rental of premises for permanent activities;

To submit a registration request using one of the following forms:

An individual artisan, a cooperative or an entrepreneur in crafts and crafts.

A- Individual craftsman: This is any natural person registered in the register of crafts and traditional crafts of the Chamber and who personally assumes the realization of the work, the management of its activity, its management and its responsibilities, and who carries out a traditional activity representative of production, creativity, transformation, technical restoration, repair or provision of a service dominated by manual work.

As such, it may carry out its activity in one of the following forms:

☐ Mobile craft activities:

The craft activity can be carried out outside the store or outside the home, and to enjoy this capacity, mobile craftsmen must meet the conditions provided for by law.

Continuous craft activities (at home):

The craft activity can be carried out inside the home, provided that it meets the requirements of traditional industry and traditional technical industry.

B - The Crafts and Crafts Cooperative: It is a civil society made up of people whose number does not exceed five partners and with non-permanent capital and is based on the freedom of association of all those who enjoy the quality of craftsman, and the cooperators enjoy equal rights whatever the share of each of them in the capital of the foundation, and it is not possible to discriminate Among the associates on the date of their joining the cooperative, the organic law of the cooperative can also specify the number of shares of the capital which must be subscribed or held by each cooperator (member) according to his commitment in the activity, and the constitution of the cooperative of crafts and dementia is evidenced by a notarized contract.

C- Craftsmanship and craft subcontracting: It is divided into two parts:

- Craft Contract:

It is any company constituted according to one of the forms provided for by the Commercial Code and having the following characteristics:

Carry out a traditional industrial activity.

Employing an unlimited number of employees.

- A department supervised by a master craftsman or craftsman or with the participation or operation of at least one other craftsman who ensures the technical direction of the company when its head does not have the quality of craftsman.

- Professional contracting for the production of materials and services:

It is any company constituted according to one of the forms provided for by the Commercial Code and having the following characteristics:

- Carry out the activity of production, transformation, maintenance, repair or provision of services in the field of craftsmanship for the production of materials and services.

Employing a number of permanent employees or artisans, the number of which does not exceed ten (10), and not counted among them:

- Responsible for contracting

Persons who, with the head of the company, have the following family ties:

- * Husband * Active and descendants * are professionals whose number does not exceed three (3) and they are bound by an apprenticeship contract in accordance with the legislation and regulations in force.

- Management by a craftsman or master craftsman, or by participation or at least another pastoral operator who ensures the technical management of the enterprise when its leader does not have the status of craftsman.

3. Registration in the National Handicrafts Register:

a). Craftsmen register file:

- ☐ A request affixed to a form submitted by the interests of the municipality.

- ☐ Documents attesting to professional qualifications, a certificate of professional competence issued by the Chamber or a certificate of professional work as a teacher for at least five years.
